Qualifications for this role include:

- Master's degree or higher in a natural resource field and one (1) year of related experience; OR,
- Bachelor's degree in a natural resource field and two (2) years of related experience; OR,
- Diploma in a natural resource field and three (3) years related experience; OR,
- An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
- Registered or immediately eligible for registration (within six (6) months of employment) as a Registered Forest Technologist (RFT) or related designation with Forest Professionals BC. Confirmation of registration/eligibility is required before an offer of employment can be made.

- Experience performing technical duties and working with key statutes that support natural resource management.
